## Programme Review Committee

### Function / Roles and Responsibilities

1. To articulate the Institute's mission statement within the framework of the University's Mission Statement;
2. To articulate the Programme Objectives;
3. To ensure alignment of the proposed courses with the programme objectives;
4. To choose suitable 'desired graduate outcomes' that can be embedded in courses;
5. To ensure academic rigor while planning academic delivery;
6. To ensure fair, transparent and robust academic deliberations.
7. To review the session plans' implementation for the previous semester and proposed session plans' for the ensuing semester;
8. To ensure that session plans incorporate evaluation such that the course objectives are met;
9. To ensure that the programme design adequately reflects incorporation of internationalization perspective;
10. To review the student/ industry feedback on the courses/ program and to evaluate the same for modification of course/ program content;
11. To review the Academic Audit report and take corrective steps wherever necessary
12. To ensure
  - Maximum possible choice to the student in the programme design in line with the spirit of CBCS framework.
  - Consideration and incorporation of relevant stakeholder feedback in the programme and course design.
  - The programme structure proposal is in the prescribed format (Currently applicable -13-point format or as may be prescribed by University from time to time) is compliant with University requirements.
13. To initiate proposals for new courses.
14. To review and propose the programme structure for the ensuing academic year (for a new batch)
15. To consider and propose revisions to the existing programme structure (for the existing batch)
16. To propose new programmes including Corporate Education Programmes if the institute is specifically authorized to do so.
17. Any other academic initiatives that require the approval of the Board of Studies or Board of University Development or Board of Examinations
